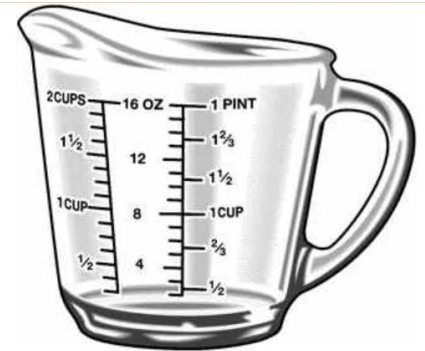




STATION 1 – MEASURING LIQUIDS

Task 1 – One person in your group should pour water from the pitcher into the measuring cup. Measure and pour 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of water into the measuring cup.

Someone else in the group should pour the water from the measuring cup into the jug with the **yellow** lid.

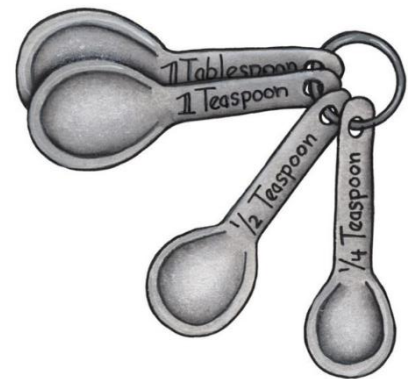


Task 2 – One person in your group should pour water from the pitcher into the measuring cup.

Measure and pour 6 ounces of water into the measuring cup.

Someone else in the group should pour the water from the measuring cup into the jug with the **green** lid.

Task 3 – Work together on this task. Use the teaspoon and the measuring cup. Count how many teaspoons it takes to fill the measuring cup to 1 cup.



Record information on your Answer Sheet.

- *Pour all water back into the pitcher with the handle before moving on to the next station.*
- *Clean up any spills you may have made.*
